Applicants must be a son, daughter, niece, and nephew, brother, sister, Grandson or Granddaughter of an ACCHI Full Member, Lifetime Member or Past Full Member who is still an Associate member of the Association of the past two years in good standing.

Criteria is enclosed as well as:

- 1) Applicants must be continuing his or her education at a post secondary institution.
- 2) The student has maintained a suitable academic achievement receiving or about to receive their grade 12 accreditation.
- 3) The student must demonstrate positive social skills within the community and the school (included in application)
- 4) Transcripts must be included with application to qualify for a scholarship.

Application forms have been included. Completed applications must be received.

The Scholarship can only be received one time throughout a lifetime; if you have applied once before and were not successful you may re-apply.

The Scholarship Committee is composed of members and associate members of the Association.

These scholarships will be presented at the Annual Meeting and Convention.

The funds associated with these scholarships will be distributed upon proof completion of the 1st Semester and the ACCHI Membership renewal for Year 2024.

Application Guidelines and Checklist

- Eligibility you must be a son, daughter, niece, and nephew, brother, sister, Grandson or Granddaughter of an ACCHI Full Member, Lifetime Member or Past Full Member who is still an Associate member of the Association of the past two years in good standing.
- Complete Scholarship application must be handwritten or printed. Each application must be completed using the application form provided. The application must have a letter of reference from a variety of people. (School principal or teacher, adult volunteer or community leader). Certified statement or transcripts or marks can be obtained from your present school or the Department of Education. Also, include a transcript of marks from your previous school year. Staple the completed application and all related materials together.

It would be a good idea to copy the application, complete it and use it as a guide to complete the final one. This helps to avoid mistakes, omissions, spelling errors, etc.

Notification and Receipt – Award winners will be notified prior to convention and **MUST** have a representative present to accept the award which will be announced at The Coast Canmore Hotel & Conference Centre, Canmore Alberta on December 7, 2023.

Completing the Application

The following sections are numbered to correspond with the application form.

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

Use your permanent address and include the personal information requested.

B. EDUCATION AND CAREER INFORMATION

Supply your present grade level or year of course if currently in secondary program. State the university or college or institution and the program you are planning to attend. Explain your career plans: What research have you done or experience do you have that leads you to believe that this course of study will lead you to a career you will find satisfying? Where do you see yourself upon completion of the course? In what areas of your chosen field do you plan to seek employment?

C. EXTRA CURRICULAR INVOVEMENT

List any school activities, sports, SRC, committees, clubs, etc.

List any community involvement, interests or hobbies

List any jobs, part-time to casual

List any organizations or association you are a member of locally or provincially.

D. ESSAY

List years of involvement responsibilities you have had on the harvest run. share the impact custom harvesting has had on your life; share harvest experiences, involvement, and goals and plans.

If you have not been active in harvest, please state why and detail what activities and/or jobs you have had during harvest time.

Make sure it is complete, single-sided, easy to read and dark enough to copy Content, sentence structure, grammar, spelling and organization are all considered. Hand-written, printed or typed essays are acceptable. Please use dark coloured ink.

E. LETTER OR REFERENCE

Include the names, occupations and relationship to the application of the person you have asked for letter or reference.

As previously mentioned, a variety of sources for your reference letters are important. This provides an opportunity to highlight different strengths and achievements you have developed or earned in the various aspects of your life; school and community. There person that you choose to write a reference for you may remember to mention a particular accomplishment or strengths of yours that you may have forgotten about or are too modest to mention yourself. If your references prefer to mail the letters directly to the Association, make sure they have the correct mailing address and the deadline. It is your responsibility to ensure that the letters arrive on time. If your application is missing components, it will be considered incomplete.

F. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Provide any information that would be helpful to the Selection Committee that was not included elsewhere. Be sure to have highlighted all different aspects of your life. Do you have any special needs or family situations that are pertinent? Any special instructions, will your reference letter or marks be forwarded separately?

G. DECLARATION OF APPLICANT

Sign and date the application

Applications that are incomplete in any way are not considered.
